<p>Layout and set up for sessions</p> <p>Coronavirus transmission through aerosol transmission or touching communal surfaces</p>	<p>Following social distancing rule of 1m+ (minimum 1m distance between participants at all times and attention paid to ventilation)</p> <p>Choir leader to be 1m+ distance from singers at all times.</p> <p>All chairs to be cleaned by West Harrow Choir members at the start and end of each rehearsal. Wipes will be available.</p> <p>Choir chairs to be separated by a distance of 1m and not facing each other, and movement during the choir session will be kept to a minimum.</p> <p>Doors and windows to be open where possible to allow maximum ventilation</p> <p>Keyboard instruments to be cleaned before use, and the same player to be allocated to each instrument throughout.</p>	<p>Choir members Choir leader/s Choir helpers/volunteers</p>
<p>Toilets</p> <p>Personnel will risk contamination by passing other people when accessing the toilets.</p>	<p>Toilets to be cleaned every day by St Peter's cleaning staff.</p> <p>People advised to wash their hands before and after using the toilet.</p> <p>People advised to clean any areas they have touched after use.</p>	<p>Choir members Choir leader/s</p>
<p>Music</p> <p>The handling of music can risk contamination</p>	<p>Singers will keep the same pieces of music for the whole project, taking them home at the end of each session.</p>	<p>Choir members Choir leader/s</p>
<p>Fire risk or emergency</p> <p>Emergency exiting may be slowed by one direction flows in venue or 2 metre distancing</p>	<p>In an emergency, for example an accident or fire, people do not have to stay 1m apart if it would be unsafe. Face coverings to be used if possible.</p> <p>All fire doors to remain clear and in use. In the event of an evacuation, all direction flows and restricted access to be disregarded.</p> <p>An evacuation will be led by staff from West Harrow Choir and a register will be taken once evacuation has safely taken place.</p>	<p>Choir members Choir leader/s</p>

<p>Personnel Personnel are at risk for contamination of COVID-19 travelling to the venue and moving around the venue.</p>	<p>West Harrow Choir Leaders will wear face coverings and observe social distancing whilst in communal areas of the building (such as hallways) and whilst not singing or leading singing sessions</p> <p>All participants to be sent the St Peter's risk assessment regarding Covid-19 restrictions.</p> <p>To participate, choir members and leaders must be free of possible symptoms (high temperature, a new and continuous cough or a loss of/change in your normal sense of taste or smell). They will also be asked to take a lateral flow test within 48 hours of the rehearsal, preferably on the day.</p> <p>All choir members told in advance to avoid contact with others including handshakes and hugs.</p> <p>Upon arrival a temperature gun will be used by a member of West Harrow Choir team to test all personnel entering the space. If a temperature of 37.8 or higher is recorded the individual will be asked to leave.</p> <p>Hands to be washed or sanitised on arrival. Sanitiser will be available at the door upon arrival, supplied by St Peter's or West Harrow Choir.</p> <p>All choir members will access the Main Hall using one-way system.</p>	<p>West Harrow Choir Leaders Choir members</p>
<p>First Aid Injury or illness of personnel including hospitalisation</p> <p>Risks of trips or falls</p> <p>Participants and staff injure themselves on equipment</p>	<p>It is the responsibility of St Peter's to ensure that a stocked first aid kit is provided and is accessible. West Harrow Choir will have a small first aid kit in their cupboard as well.</p> <p>Social distancing and hygiene practices will be maintained as far as possible, including limiting the number of people assisting a person becoming unwell or injured.</p> <p>If possible, casualty to administer the necessary first aid themselves under supervision of a trained person (i.e. applying their own plasters etc). If a 1m distance is not possible the first aider will wear disposable gloves and use alcohol gel before and after treatment.</p> <p>Any personnel involved in administering first aid will be required to dispose of PPE and wash their hands and face thoroughly afterwards.</p>	<p>Choir members Choir leader/s</p>
